- Registered Boy Scouts, Varsity Scouts or Venturers.
- Completed BSA Annual Health & Medical Record.
- Summit Risk Acknowledgment

## ACTIVITY PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

CANOPY TOURS, CHALLENGE COURSES & ZIP LINES  
– Manufacturers guidelines require that participants weigh between 50 and 250 pounds regardless of height.

WATER ACTIVITIES – Must successfully complete the BSA Swim Test. All water activities require closed toed shoes during participation.

- Two pairs of shoes (one for water activities)
- Jacket

### WHITEWATER RAFTING

While whitewater trips are not part of the Mountaineer Weekend program, many units have found it convenient to schedule whitewater trips on Thursdays immediately prior to arrival at the Summit.

When planning a whitewater trip, we recommend contacting a professional, licensed outfitter.
