REGISTRATION REMINDERS

- Ensure that participants are registered in the National Registration system and not just in/through your local payment system;
- Continue to approve/decline registrants and assign troop #'s using the updated link and instructions provided in the email sent on Feb. 1st (AHMR's are not processed for participants that are not assigned to a troop.)



REGISTRATION (Cont.)

- Remind participants that they can edit/withdraw their own registrations without Jamboree Registration office/Help Desk involvement - Refunds to withdrawn participants are administered at the Council level;
- Participants should upload their photograph into their application; while it will not be printed onto the 2017 credential, it will be helpful in the event of an emergency situation (such as Lost person on property);



REGISTRATION (Cont.)

- PAPERWORK:
 - Anyone who plans to raft MUST have a signed rafting waiver in their possession prior to leaving for their scheduled trip;
 - Annual Health and Medical Records – paper form is still to be completed by your physician; information to be entered by participants into online Medical system created for Jamboree

MEDICAL CHECKS

- Jamboree AHMRs submitted on or before to **April 19, 2017** will be processed before the Jamboree.
- Jamboree AHMRs submitted after April 19, 2017 will be accepted and processed as soon as possible, but submission after April 19, 2017 may result in a significant slow down for the individual and/or their Unit at on-site registration until the individual's AHMR is cleared.
- Remember that AMHRs can be submitted, but cannot be reviewed or approved until you complete the troop assignment.



RIVER RAFTING

Council allocations have been finalized but we still have some slots to give away if any Councils still might need a few more slots for their contingent.

We will be sending an email to each Council contact no later than the end of this month which will contain a Google form for you to complete. We'll ask you to list each of your Jamboree Troop #'s and the number within each troop who will be rafting (the sum should equal your Council's total allocation). Whether you have one troop or many, please help us by entering your information.

We're creating a database from the info to work out the actual scheduling.
