RIVER RAFTING

- Rafting spots will be allocated to council contingents by jamboree administration
- Contingent leadership will assign the available spots to participants (adult and/or youth)
- Rafting trips will be scheduled by unit
- An adult leader will need to accompany the youth participants to check-in with completed waivers

- Opportunity to complete Day of Service before/after Jamboree.
 - Contingent must be traveling via vehicle from home council
 - Contingents traveling via air will complete their service during the jamboree

- Every participant must apply to attend the jamboree through the online application system.
- Councils should be communicating the participant selection process and pricing to interested individuals.
- Please encourage adult leader applicants that are not selected as adult leaders to consider attending jamboree as volunteer staff.

STATUS	DEFINTION
New	Application has not yet BSA membership verified, is incomplete, or is awaiting parental approval.
Pending Level 1 Review	Awaiting council approval
Level 1 Approved	Council has approved
Level 1 Declined	Council has declined
Waitlisted	Council has placed participant on waitlist.
Level 2 Approved	Approved by the Jamboree office
Level 2 Declined	Declined by the Jamboree office
Pending 1st Choice Review	Volunteer Staff application is at the 1st job preference of the applicant.
Pending 2nd Choice Review	Volunteer Staff application is at the 2nd job preference of the applicant.
Pending 3rd Choice Review	Volunteer Staff application is at the 3rd preference of the applicant.
Free Agent	Volunteer Staff application has cycled through all three job preferences of the application and is now available for any staffing managers to view.
Position Offered - Pending Acceptance	Volunteer Staff applicant has been sent a job offer and the offer is awaiting review by applicant.
Position Offered - Accepted	Volunteer Staff applicant has accepted a position that has been offered.
Declined - Medical	Medical was declined. Participant will be notified by Jamboree office.
Withdrawn	Participant withdrew the application.
Cancelled	Application was cancelled in Jamboree office at the participant's request.

IMPORTANT NOTE FOR COUNCILS

ONCE YOU HAVE APPROVED AN APPLICATION,
PLEASE DO NOT 'APPROVE' IT AGAIN.

It will move the application back to 'level 1
approved' and the applicant will lose any
further approvals that have already taken place.

COUNCIL REPORTS

Each council has access to three reports in the Jamboree Application System

- Contingent Application Report shows all youth and adult leader applications from council
- Staff Applications Council Report shows all volunteer staff applications from council
- Summary Report shows a summary of all applicants (youth, adult, and staff) and their application status.

2017 JAMBOREE REGISTRATION INFORMATION

This is the place to sign up for the 2017 National Jamboree!

To submit a **NEW** application, you will need your My.Scouting username and password. If you do not have a My.Scouting account, please go to My.Scouting.org and follow the directions to create an account.

If you need technical support, call Member Care Services at **(972) 580-2489**.

A handful of things to be sure of:

1. The My.Scouting account needs to be in the name of the person attending the Jamboree, not the parent/guardian that is completing the application for a youth participant.
2. The My.Scouting account you use should also be linked to your current BSA membership number.
3. The membership number that you linked to your Jamboree application will be linked to the entire process, including your BSA Health & Medical Record.
4. All applicants must have a current, non-expired, BSA membership.
5. Use Chrome, Firefox or IE 10 or above to access the Jamboree application. Other browsers may not be compatible with this system.

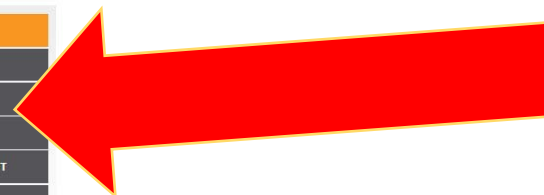
