We are in search of volunteers to come to the Summit during our 2020 season to assist in staffing our Health Lodge. In addition to ou multiple programs running, we will also have Venturing Fest as and the National Law Enforcement Exploring Conference. Ideally, each week we would have 2-3 teams of a provider and nurse so that shifts can be spread out. While onsite, you will have the opportunity to get involved with some our our programs as space and time permit. You will sleep in an air conditioned facility with hot showers. The only cost for you is your transportation to and from the Summit. If you would like to bring your family, we can make accommodations in one of the houses at the Railroad tracks just outside the site. If you have an RV that you would prefer to sleep in, we can make accommodations for that as well.

All volunteers must apply for a Summit Health Services permit which will give you permission to practice onsite without having to obtain a West Virginia license. The Summit Health Services permit also provides you with malpractice insurance while practicing on Summit property.

There are Mount Hope Fire Department EMT's onsite at all times to assist you with getting emergency patients into the Health Lodge. You will have UTV or vehicle access onsite. We also have a full-time paid staff member in the Health Lodge to assist you with record keeping and staff from Raleigh General will be available to help coordinate outpatient care and hospital transfers.
