The Summit provides this optional award under the guidance of the unit Chaplain Aide. The goal of the award is to assist a participant in living out his/her "Duty to God."

To earn this award, please complete the following requirements:

- Unit Chaplain Aide must attend the Chaplain Aide training on: For Scout Camp – Sunday evening; For Summit Experience – on the evening you arrive;
- Participants should attend Summit Scout Vespers on Monday @ 8:15 next to the Scott Visitor Center and behind Health Lodge, or conduct unit led Vespers during your stay;
- 3. Participate in daily devotionals guided by the Chaplain Aide. Devotional resources are provided on Linktree under "Chaplain Aide Resources;" or search "SBR Chaplain Aide Resources;"
- 4. Unit should participate in a daily "Thorns, Roses and Buds" session guided by the Chaplain Aide, and;
