This BSA Leave No Trace Master Educator Course provides participants with comprehensive training in Leave No Trace skills and ethics, instruction and practice on effective teaching methods, and information on the important role of outdoor ethics in scouting's outdoor programs.

This **5-day course** features a day of classroom instruction at the Summit, 3 days and nights of immersive practical application in a variety of "frontcountry" settings designed to replicate typical Scouting outdoor programs.

A major goal for this course is to graduate effective and active Leave No Trace Master Educators who will return to their home council and conduct the key Leave No Trace

Trainer courses needed to support their unit, district, and council outdoor programs.
