

Summit Bechtel Reserve Hunter Education Certification Program 2025

The Summit Bechtel Reserve Hunter Education Certification Program provides Scouts and leaders with the opportunity to receive their hunter education cards while on site participating in any of our summer programming activities. The program is held at the Crafton Sportsman Complex (Action Point) in Hunter's Hall and includes opportunities to shoot Laser Shot at our state-of-the-art virtual shooting range in the Crafton Skills Center.

Before arriving on site:

1. Go to the link for the **West Virginia Division of Natural Resources** registration site (see below) and sign up for the course that matches your arrival date.
2. Once registered, go to the **WVDNR.gov** website and take one of the 5 Hunter Education Courses in which 4 have a fee and the last one, the www.nrahe.org course, is free. **You must take the course through the West Virginia DNR Website.**
3. Once you pass the test, bring your Completed Field Day Voucher with you to the Summit to take the "hands on" Hunter Education Certification class and final course test for certification. Take a picture of your Voucher on your phone as a backup.
4. Summer Camp courses will be taught on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm and 1:00 pm – 5:00 pm in the Joe Crafton Hunter's Hall building at Action Point.
5. Once all requirements are met, participants will receive a West Virginia Hunter Education Card which will allow them to purchase a hunting license in any of the 50 states, plus Mexico, Canada, and the United Kingdom. In addition, participants will receive a Hunter Education patch, certificate, game call, and bracelet.

If you are a participant in Scout Camp or Summit Experience during Summer Camp and wish to receive an **"official"** Hunter Education card, please register for the course based on your **"arrival"** date listed below. **Special Note: The registration link is set up for Friday from 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm for all courses. Based on your program schedule, your "actual" date and time for taking Hunter Education may be different than the registration link that is listed.**
